



## Wanda Buckley

September 17, 1928 - August 29, 2009

Wanda Buckley 80, longtime resident of Beggs, Oklahoma died on August 29, 2009 after a brave battle with cancer. She was born on September 17, 1928 in Hominy, Oklahoma to Ralph and Clara (Windsor) Potts. She married Kenneth D. Buckley on May 25, 1946.

Mrs. Buckley will long be remembered as President of the Women's Society of Christian Service, longtime Sunday School Teacher at the First Methodist Church in Beggs, where she was a member.
