Weeta Joycelyn Tucker, 80 year old resident of Okmulgee, passed away Monday, March 6, 2017 in Okmulgee. She was born April 23, 1936 in Paoli, Oklahoma to the late James Claude and Mary Florence (Keener) Whitaker. She married Clyde J. Tucker on July 3, 1953 in Purcell, Oklahoma. He preceded her in death on November 7, 2011. Weeta was a Charter Member of the Trinity Baptist Church in Morris, co-founder of AGAPE Pregnancy Center and was a member of the Baptist Village Bell Choir. She was also a Red Hatter and formerly active in the Okmulgee Chamber of Commerce. Weeta was a longtime Okmulgee area real estate agent. She cherished the time she spent with her family.
