William Stenhouse "Bill" Wilson, 91, longtime resident of Okmulgee, died Friday, January 28, 2011 at the Colonial Lodge Nursing Home in McAlister. He was born September 21, 1919 in Hartford, Arkansas to the late John and Jeanette (Stenhouse) Wilson.
